

Information Sheet for Obtaining Medical Records for Candidates with Previous Foreign Military Service

All candidates with previous foreign military service are responsible for providing ADF Careers (ADFC) medical sections with a copy of their in-service medical records. Due to time delays in obtaining the records it is recommended the records be requested ASAP to ensure your application for entry into the ADF is not unnecessarily delayed. The medical records need to be reviewed by the ADFC Medical Officer before you can be medically cleared. Candidates experiencing difficulties obtaining records are to advise the ADFC medical section.
